



## **NEW ENROLMENT PROCESS FOR TERM 2 and BEYOND**

As we move forward and roll over to Term 2 and beyond please make note of the new procedures;

1. Ensure all your personal details are updated on the Parental Portal (located on the website)
2. EARLY BIRD PAYMENT; Pay your next term fees in full before the start of new term and go into the draw for a chance to win a \$100 REBEL Voucher. (**All payments to be received by Friday 13th April**)
3. Members WILL now roll-over from term to term. Changes are only required if your child changes days, and / or is promoted to another group. The office will contact you if your child is being promoted.
4. Please contact the office if you wish to change days. Classes are subject to availability.
5. To be eligible to roll over to the next term the following terms and conditions must be met;
  - a. All current term fees are up to date. Failure to pay your fees will result in your spot not being allocated to you for the new term
  - b. You DO NOT need to pay a holding fee / nor notify of your intention to remain in your current class.
6. Please advise the office if you are not returning in the new term by no later than Tuesday 10th April

The final class for Term ONE will be **Thursday 29th March**.

There will be no classes on Friday 30th March, Saturday 31st March due to the Easter period.

Term TWO will commence on **MONDAY 16th April**, run for ELEVEN weeks, concluding on Saturday 30th June. Please be aware of the Public Holidays on;

- Wednesday - 25th April for Anzac Day
- Monday - 11th June for Queens Birthday.

Classes that fall on those days will have adjustments made accordingly.
